

COLLEGE COMMUNITY AGREEMENT

St Andrew's Anglican College is a community comprising students, parents and staff. Based on our Christian foundation in the Anglican tradition, we leverage our positive energy and supportive community to enable our students to move confidently into their futures.

Our core value statements talk about encouraging learning, creating opportunities and building community and in order to live by these, we require all members of our community to build respectful relationships, to promote personal best to serve others and to embed Christ like action. This means we treat others with dignity and graciousness, understanding the importance of co-operating in a community with diverse interests and traditions.

Every student will take personal responsibility for their own development by diligent and careful preparation for, and participation in, all the classes and activities of which they are a member. Respectful relationship requires us all to be conscious of the learning needs of others and how our actions may affect them also.

As a member of the St Andrew's Anglican College community, I agree to:

1. Respect the right of teachers to teach and students to learn.
2. Display politeness, tolerance and respect towards others at all times. It is expected that I will demonstrate courtesy to all students, members of staff and visitors within the College grounds and local community.
3. Be at the College and ready to start class at the designated time.
4. Conduct myself appropriately while at the College, when travelling to and from the College and whenever representing the College.
5. Use appropriate language at all times and avoid any use of profanity.
6. Embrace and reflect the high standards expected by the College. This includes standard of dress and personal appearance at all times, and particularly when representing the College in the wider community. I will wear my uniform with pride and keep all items of the uniform clean and in good repair.
7. Demonstrate responsible care for the College environment and the property of others. I will develop an attitude of care and concern for my own property and the property of others.
8. Be within the College campus grounds during the designated hours of the school day and sign in and out as required at the relevant sub-school office.
9. Attend the various formal events (for example, Foundation Day, Presentation Evening) in the College calendar, as relevant to the sub-school.
10. Participate in sport, excursions, camp and other curriculum related activities etc unless exempt by a medical certificate.
11. Refrain from the use of or involvement with tobacco/vaping, alcohol, illegal substances or banned items. The College has a zero-tolerance policy regarding illegal substances.
12. Acknowledge and support the role of the duly appointed student leaders.
13. Use technology, including mobile phones, appropriately, as outlined in the relevant College policies.
